PROVIDES THEM WITH EDUCATIONAL OPPURTUNITIES

Each year, we accept 10-15 new students to become part of the BOSANA scholarship program and/or the Professional Development program which allows them to study and further develop their skills.

SUPPORTS THEM FINANCIALLY THROUGH SCHOLARSHIPS

BOSANA provides scholarships to students from all over Bosnia and Herzegovina. Part of the monthly scholarships cover faculty costs, materials and accommodation if needed.





TEAM-BUILDING ACTIVITIES

Yearly, students have the oppurtunity to participate in a trip somewhere in BIH. Usully, we go rafting or we play team building games to connect with each other as well as to learn more about the place we visit together.
