Out of these, 76 students have successfully completed their B.A. degrees and 25 of them have even completed their M.A. degrees. This high percentage speaks a great deal about our professional development program and all the additional training we offer our students as they enter their final year of college. Our Bosana mentors also provide valuable contributions to the success of our students and I would like to personally acknowledge their time and dedication.

Navigating Success: BOSANA's Specialized Career Development Program

This year, 10 Bosana students participated in the 'Kick-start Your Career' (KYC) Program, founded in 2019 in collaboration with Aida Sujoldžić, a psychologist with more than fifteen years of professional experience in talent management, career consulting, soft skills training, and executive coaching.

At this year's KSYC program, we also had the pleasure of hosting **Faruk Gutić**, a young medical doctor, who delivered a brief presentation on the advantages of networking and engagement through LinkedIn!





Kick-start Your Career was a highly positive experience for me. The simulated job interviews were particularly beneficial, providing insights into potential questions and tricky situations. Just months later, I applied these lessons during my first job interview, securing an internship with a major pharmaceutical company. 


From Scholarship to Philanthropy: 57 Completed Projects Through **Students for Humanity Initiative**

For 9 years now, Bosana students have all set aside part of their monthly scholarship funds and they continue to do so even today.

This year, our Students for Humanity project successfully supported nine (9) students and families for a total amount of 3.120 BAM (1749.32\$).

Actions were implemented in the following municipalities and cities: Tuzla, Maglaj, Bihać, Banja Luka, Travnik, Bijeljina, Živinice, Sarajevo, Milići-Vlasenica, Srebrenica, Zenica, Jajce, Kakanj, Bosanska Krupa, Bileća, Foča, Mostar, Doboj, Sanski Most, Vareš, Ljubovija, Konjic, Goražde.

After School Tutoring For **Orphans in BIH**

Orphans face educational challenges, limiting their college opportunities.

In a country with a 46% unemployment rate, they need improved education, life skills, and vocational training for better employment prospects.





4 distinct afterschool programs in Zenica, Tuzla, and Sarajevo

- Over 80 children and 15 active volunteer scholarship holders in the program.
- 3 of our students, out of 4 volunteers, are actively engaged in activities in Mostar,
- 17 out of 50 kids are included in the After School Program in Mostar
- 7 of our students, out of 8 volunteers, are actively engaged in activities in Sarajevo.
- 2 of our students are part of a team consisting of 7 volunteers actively engaged in activities in Zenica.
- · More than 30 out of 57 kids are included in the After School Program in Tuzla
- Around 40 out of 80 kids are included in After School Program in both Sarajevo and Zenica

Highlights from 2023

- We launched a pilot After School Program in Mostar, Bosnia and Herzegovina, driven by the motivation and empowerment Inspired by the program.
- In Sarajevo, since October, four new volunteers have officially joined, bringing the total number of volunteers to seven.
- · The implementation of an Instructional teaching database streamlines work monitoring for both home volunteers and employees.
- · The recently appointed program assistant for Sarajevo and Mostar is Romana, a former scholarship recipient and alumnus of the Bosana Foundation
- · New program Coordinator in Tuzla is Azra, current scholarship recipient and her assistant is Mili, former coordinator and scholarship recipient



You will notice that Bosana's Operational Expenses in 2023 surpassed our usual total up to 15% of total annual expenses because in this year we have made an executive decision to hire two former Bosana students in BIH to help us run our scholarship program and engage better with our donors. We plan to have an increased number of donations in 2024 to justify this investment to help Bosana grow and build a better relationship with our donors and students.
